MIRRORLIAR FILMS

is a short film production project that aims to nurture and discover creators in Japan.

36 short films created by actors, film directors, manga artists and musicians were released in Seasons 1 to 4 in 2021-22. Because they are short films, they provide an opportunity for creators from various background not usually involved in film production to come together and try their hand at short filmmaking, creating a place where new perspectives and ideas are born.

In Seasons 5-8, which will be released sequentially from spring 2024, each season will be based in a different region in Japan and run as a regional promotion and education project, utilising the Japanese tax incentive program that encourages companies to donate to local governments for tax credit.

The aim of this public-participation project is to bring as many people as possible into contact with filmmaking, with a public-private executive committee, production and screening with citizen participation, and film production workshops for students and citizens.





EIHI SHINA

KOTONOHA artist (artist-actress)

In 1994, she made her modeling debut in the Benetton World Campaign in Paris. Her advertisements, shot by world-renowned photographer Oliviero Toscani, became a worldwide sensation, and since then she has been featured in magazines, advertisements, and numerous collections, attracting attention as a rare individual who can express her worldview in any field, from Lolita to mode.

After retiring from modeling, she worked as an artist, holding solo exhibitions at art museums, before making her debut as an actress.

In 2000, she played the lead role of Asami in Takashi Miike's film "AUDITION," and her uncanny performance was immediately greeted with shock by film industry professionals around the world. Twenty-five years after the film's release, she remains legendarily popular.

In 2021, she resumed her artistic activities, including directing her first film "EIHI SHIINA VISUALBUM".

WORLD PREMIERE

EIHI SHIINA VISUALBUM

(2024)

Dir. Eihi Shiina Drama

Following the Great East Japan Earthquake in 2011, this is Eihi Shiina's first film as a director, which she directed, wrote, acted in, and art produced as the culmination of her activities to date.

The trilogy of short films, 1st "KOTONOHA", 2nd "KOTONONE", and 3rd "KOTONOHANA" was



created in Japan with the theme of life, death and nirvana.

The beautiful and sorrowful visual poetry depicted from Eihi Shiina's original point of view is her brain itself, in which everything she has is concentrated. It is her last message (a will) as an artist to Japan and the world.




LEGEND OF The Stardust Brothers

Things go badly for a hack director and film crew shooting a low budget zombie movie in an abandoned WWII Japanese facility, when they are attacked by real zombies.






